	(1 unit = 100 cubic feet = 748 gallons)	
<b>S-09-1</b>	<b>Residential Sewer Service</b>	
	Rate is billed bi-monthly year around but uses wintertime average water consumption for Summer/Fall months. Where winter consumption information is not available, summer/fall billings are based on 77% of actual water use.	\$ 8.35
<b>S-09-2</b>	<b>Non-Residential Service</b>	
	Rate is billed bi-monthly year around using actual readings for each billing period. <sup>(b)</sup>	\$ 8.35
